The Philippines is planning to introduce nuclear power into its energy mix, targeting 1.2 gigawatts of nuclear capacity by 2032 through small modular reactors, microreactors, and other advanced technologies – creating significant opportunities for U.S. firms. Seeking to engage the full U.S. civil nuclear energy ecosystem, the delegation will present opportunities for U.S. suppliers, industry associations, nonprofits, and other potential partners that can share best practices, provide technical expertise, and support their workforce and capacity-building efforts.
