Assessing Social Security's Financial Outlook

On Tuesday, August 31, Social Security's Board of Trustees issued its annual report to Congress outlining the financial outlook for the Old-Age, Survivors, and Disability Insurance Trust Funds. The 2021 OASDI Trustees Report is the first actuarial projections to reflect the potential effects of the COVID pandemic. The report projects the combined reserves to become depleted in 2034, one year sooner than last year.

On Friday, September 3, Social Security's Chief Actuary will brief the Board on the actuarial projections of these programs in public session. Two independent experts – one from the American Enterprise Institute and one from the Economic Policy Institute – will provide discussant remarks.
