Assessing Social Security's Financial Outlook

1 – 2:30 pm On Tuesday, August 31, Social Security's Board of

Trustees issued its annual report to Congress outlining the financial outlook for the Old-Age,

Survivors, and Disability Insurance Trust Funds. The 2021 OASDI Trustees Report is the first actuarial

projections to reflect the potential effects of the COVID pandemic. The report projects that the Social Security trust funds have enough incoming revenues and reserves to pay full benefits until 2034, after which incoming revenue will be sufficient to pay 78 percent of scheduled benefits.

On Friday, September 3, Social Security's Chief Actuary briefed the Board on the actuarial projections of these programs in public session. Two independent experts – one from the American Enterprise Institute and one from the Economic Policy Institute –provided discussant remarks.
