

Official Rules
Minnesota State Lottery
Facebook Sweepstakes
\$2021 Social Sweepstakes
Friday, January 8, 2021–Friday, January 15, 2021

1. To be eligible to win a player must:
 - A. be a registered member of Facebook (www.facebook.com);
 - B. be 18 years of age or older;
 - C. be a resident of the state of Minnesota with a Minnesota U.S. Postal Service mailing address;
 - D. have commented “TMN” and tagged a friend on the \$2021 Social Sweepstakes post on the Minnesota Lottery Facebook page between 12:00 a.m. central time (“CT”) on Friday January 8, 2021, and 11:59 p.m. (CT) on Friday, January 15, 2021.
2. Employees (including immediate family residing in the same household) of the Minnesota State Lottery (the “Lottery”), employees (including immediate family residing in the same household) of any company that is not eligible to receive a prize from the Lottery pursuant to law or a contract with the Lottery, and all other persons prohibited by law are ineligible to participate or receive a prize from this sweepstakes.
3. The prizewinners will be drawn at random from all eligible entries at Lottery Headquarters by Lottery representatives on or about Tuesday, January 19, 2021. The name and city of the prizewinners may be posted on mnlottery.com and/or Lottery social media channels following prizewinner verification.
4. One (1) drawing will occur, and one (1) prize will be awarded. The prizewinner will receive two thousand twenty-one dollars (\$2021), one (1) Minnesota Lottery-logo steel can coozie, one (1) Minnesota Lottery-logo magnetic bottle opener, one (1) Minnesota Lottery-logo deck of playing cards, and one (1) Minnesota Lottery-logo T-shirt. The approximate taxable prize value is \$2021. The Lottery reserves the right to substitute or omit prizes for any reason, including availability. A prizewinner may win only once. One winner per household. The Lottery offers no express or implied warranty or guarantee of merchandise prizes.
5. The Lottery will use information provided on winning Sweepstakes entry forms to verify the winners. Incomplete information may result in entry disqualification. If the Lottery is unable to verify a winning entry, the Lottery will deem it ineligible and the player will not be entitled to any prize.
6. Prizes will be shipped to the U.S. Postal Service mailing address provided in the Winner Affidavit form following verification. If a prize is returned to the Lottery,

the Lottery may declare the prize forfeited by the player and the player will have no further right to the prize and the Lottery may award the prize to another player.

7. By entering this sweepstakes, prizewinners' consent to full use of any and all information they provide on the entry form for publicity, public relations, and content creation purposes, including on Lottery social media channels and mnlottery.com, by the Lottery. Prizewinners may be required to execute an Affidavit of Eligibility form and appropriate releases and authorizations. Refusal to do so may result in forfeiture of any prize won.
8. The odds of winning are determined by the total number of entries received.
9. A prize won may not be assigned or transferred to another person. Federal, state, or local taxes on any prize are the sole responsibility of the prizewinner. All applicable federal, state, or local laws apply. Void where prohibited by law.
10. Each player whose entry was selected in a Social Media Sweepstakes drawing to win a prize valued at \$600 or more must fill out and submit a Winner Affidavit form to the Lottery. If the claim is not validated by the Lottery, the claim will be denied, and the player will be notified immediately. If a prizewinner is delinquent in the payment of Minnesota state taxes or owes a debt as defined in Minn. Stat. § 270A.03, subd. 5, the amount due will be deducted from the value of the prize, and the Lottery will forward all or sufficient proceeds received to the Department of Revenue to satisfy or partially satisfy the debt on the prizewinner's behalf. If any cash remains after the Lottery has forwarded the proceeds to the Minnesota Department of Revenue, the prizewinner will be awarded the remaining cash.
11. This sweepstakes begins at 12:00 a.m. CT on Friday January 8, 2021, and concludes at 11:59 p.m. (CT) on Friday, January 15, 2021.

13. These sweepstakes rules may be amended at any time by the Lottery. By participating, players agree to these official rules and to the decisions of the Lottery which will be final and binding in all respects.

If, for any reason it is not possible to run all or any part of the \$2021 Social Sweepstakes as planned due to, without limitation, errors in these official rules or advertising for this sweepstakes, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, human error, or any other cause beyond the control of

the Lottery that, in the sole judgment of the Lottery, could corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of this sweepstakes, the Lottery reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the sweepstakes.
