

**Official Rules  
Minnesota State Lottery  
Facebook Sweepstakes  
First Avenue Social Sweepstakes  
Thursday, March 25, 2021 – Friday, March 26, 2021**

1. To be eligible to win a player must:
  - A. be a registered member of Facebook ([www.facebook.com](http://www.facebook.com));
  - B. be 18 years of age or older;
  - C. be a resident of the state of Minnesota with a Minnesota U.S. Postal Service mailing address;
  - D. have commented “TMN” on the Minnesota Lottery Facebook First Avenue Social Sweepstakes page between 10:00 a.m. central time (“CT”) on Thursday, March 25, 2021, and 9:59 a.m. (CT) on Friday, March 26, 2021.
2. Employees (including immediate family residing in the same household) of the Minnesota State Lottery (the “Lottery”), employees (including immediate family residing in the same household) of any company that is not eligible to receive a prize from the Lottery pursuant to law or a contract with the Lottery, and all other persons prohibited by law are ineligible to participate or receive a prize from this sweepstakes.
3. The prizewinners will be drawn at random from all eligible entries at Lottery Headquarters by Lottery representatives on or about Friday, March 26, 2021. The name and city of the prizewinners may be posted on [mnlottery.com](http://mnlottery.com) and/or Lottery social media channels following prizewinner verification.
4. One (1) drawing will occur, and ten (10) prizes will be awarded. Each prizewinner will receive one (1) Minnesota Lottery-logo bamboo bottle opener, one (1) Minnesota Lottery-logo round cooler, one (1) Minnesota Lottery-logo steel tumbler, one (1) First Avenue T-shirt, one (1) First Avenue hat, one (1) pair of First Avenue socks, and fifty dollars (\$50) in Minnesota Lottery scratch tickets. The approximate taxable prize value is \$50. The Lottery reserves the right to substitute or omit prizes for any reason, including availability. A prizewinner may win only once. One winner per household. The Lottery offers no express or implied warranty or guarantee of merchandise prizes.
5. The Lottery will use information provided on winning sweepstakes entry forms to verify the winners. Incomplete information may result in entry disqualification. If the Lottery is unable to verify a winning entry, the Lottery will deem it ineligible, and the player will not be entitled to any prize.
6. Prizes will be shipped to the U.S. Postal Service mailing address provided in the Winner Affidavit form following verification. If a prize is returned to the Lottery, the Lottery may declare the prize forfeited by the player and the player will have

no further right to the prize and the Lottery may award the prize to another player.

7. By entering this sweepstakes, prizewinners consent to full use of any and all information they provide on the entry form for publicity, public relations, and content creation purposes, including on Lottery social media channels and [mnlottery.com](http://mnlottery.com), by the Lottery. Prizewinners may be required to execute a Winner Affidavit form and appropriate releases and authorizations. Refusal to do so may result in forfeiture of any prize won.
8. The odds of winning are determined by the total number of entries received.
9. A prize won may not be assigned or transferred to another person. Federal, state, or local taxes on any prize are the sole responsibility of the prizewinner. All applicable federal, state, or local laws apply. Void where prohibited by law.
10. This sweepstakes begins at 10:00 a.m. central time (CT) on Thursday, March 25, 2021, and concludes 9:59 a.m. (CT) on Friday, March 26, 2021.
